Educational Qualification :

(a) Science Subjects

Candidates should have passed **Intermediate/10+2/ Equivalent examination** with **Mathematics, Physics and English** from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum **50% marks** in aggregate and **50% marks** in English.

OR

Passed **Three years Diploma Course in Engineering** (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from Central, State and UT recognized Polytechnic institute with **50% marks** in aggregate and **50% marks** in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).

OR

Passed **Two years Vocational Course** with non-vocational subject viz. **Physics and Mathematics** from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with **50% marks** in aggregate and **50% marks** in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

(b) Other than Science Subjects

Passed Intermediate / 10+2 / Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum **50% marks** in aggregate and **50% marks** in English.

OR

Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum **50% marks** in aggregate and **50% marks** in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

Note - 1: Candidates eligible for Science Subjects examination (Including Intermediate/ 10+2/three years diploma course in engineering or two years vocational course with non-vocational subjects of Physics and Maths) are also eligible for Other than Science Subjects and would be given an option of appearing in both Science Subjects and Other than Science Subjects examination in one sitting while filling up the online registration form.

- Published to the new web methodology for induction of Agniveerayu under Agnipath Scheme, aimed to provide an opportunity to Indian youth to experience military life of IAF for a period of four years. Indian Air Force invites ONLINE applications from unmarried Indian male and female candidates for selection test from 17 January 2024 onwards to join the IAF as an AGNIVEERVAYU. The number and employability of female candidates will be decided as per service requirement.
- THE SELECTION TEST IS NOT FOR SELECTION AS COMMISSIONED OFFICERS/PILOTS/NAVIGATORS(AFM).
- Application is required to be filed only ONLINE by the candidates and detailed instructions to fill up the same are available at www.airforceindia.com
- The examination is held by AGNIVEERVAYU INTAKE 01/2025
- ONLINE REGISTRATION shall commence at 11:00 AM on 17 January 2024 and will close at 23:00H on 06 February 2024. Only ONLINE REGISTERED applications shall be accepted. For registration log on to <https://www.airforceindia.com>

- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**
- Age**
 - Date of Birth Block: Candidate born between 02 January 2004 and 02 July 2007 (both dates inclusive) are eligible to apply.
 - In case a candidate clears all the stages of the Selection Procedure then the upper age limit as on date of enrolment should be 21 years.
 - Marital Status and Pregnancy** Only unmarried candidates (male & female) will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveerayu and they shall undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Keeping in view limited period of engagement of Agniveerayu inclusive of training, skill development activities, practical as well as formative assessment and organisational requirement of continued service of Agniveerayu during the engagement period, longer absence of Agniveerayu during the engagement period will adversely affect the operational efficiency of the Indian Air Force. Agniveerayu who marry during the said period shall be discharged from the service. Further, only unmarried Agniveerayu will be eligible for promotion in regular cadre as Airman. Female candidates additionally shall be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period of four years. Single women Agniveerayu on becoming Low Medical Category (LMC) due to pregnancy shall be liable to be discharged from service. Pregnancy will disqualify the women Agniveerayu for selection into Regular Cadre. At the time of enrolment, candidates shall require to sign a voluntary undertaking accepting above conditions.

- Educational Qualification**
 - Science Subjects**
Candidates should have passed Intermediate/10+2 Equivalent examination with Mathematics, Physics and English from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.
OR
Passed Three years Diploma Course in Engineering (Mechanical / Electrical / Electronics / Automobile / Computer Science / Instrumentation Technology / Information Technology) from Central, State and UT recognised Polytechnic institute with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Diploma Course (or in Intermediate/Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Diploma Course).
OR
Passed Two years Vocational Course with non-vocational subject viz. Physics and Mathematics from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation, if English is not a subject in Vocational Course).
 - Other than Science Subjects**
Passed Intermediate / 10+2 Equivalent Examination in any stream/subjects from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English.
OR
Passed two years Vocational Course from Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT with minimum 50% marks in aggregate and 50% marks in English in Vocational Course (or in Intermediate / Matriculation / English is not a subject in Vocational Course).

Note-1: Candidates eligible for Science Subjects examination (Including Intermediate / 10+2 three years diploma course in engineering or two years vocational course with non-vocational subjects of Physics and Maths) are also eligible for Other than Science Subjects and would be given an option of appearing in both Science Subjects and Other than Science Subjects examination in one sitting while filling up the online registration form.

Note-2: Education Boards recognized by Central, State and UT as on date of registrations shall only be considered.

Note-3: Exact aggregate Percentage of marks before decimal as written in the marks sheet of 10+2/Intermediate/Equivalent Examination/Three years Diploma Course/Two years Vocational Course OR calculated as per the rules of concerned Education Board / Polytechnic institute shall only be considered (For example 49.99% should be taken as 49% and not to be rounded off to 50%).

- Mandatory Medical Standards** Overall Medical Standards for AGNIVEERVAYU male & female candidates are as follows:
 - Height:**
 - For Male candidates, Minimum acceptable height is 152.5 cms
 - For Female candidates, Minimum acceptable height is 152 cms. For candidates belonging to North East or hilly regions of Uttarakhand a lower minimum height of 147 cms will be accepted. In case of candidates from Lakshadweep the minimum height will be 150 cms.

Note: Candidates availing height relaxation for being domicile of North East/Hilly Regions of Uttarakhand/Lakshadweep are to submit medical certificate with endorsement of female status at the time of Phase II testing. Further, candidates from hilly regions of Uttarakhand must have specific endorsement of hilly region in their domicile certificate.
 - Weight:** Proportionate to height.
 - Chest:**
 - For Male Candidates: The chest wall should be well proportioned and well developed. Minimum chest circumference should be 77 cms and the chest expansion should be atleast 05 cms.
 - For Female candidates, The chest wall should be well proportioned and well developed with the minimum range of expansion of 05 cms.
 - Hearing:** Candidate should have normal hearing i.e. able to hear forced whisper from a distance of 6 meters by each ear separately.
 - Dental:** Should have healthy dentition of teeth and minimum 14 dental points.

- Conceal Surgery (PRK/LASIK) is not acceptable.**
Note: Candidates should bring prescription and spectacles for corrected vision, if being used. The latest prescription should contain diopter measurement, ocular health, name, number, name, signature and date of prescription should be within a month prior to appearing for medical examination.
- General Health:** Candidates should be of normal build without loss of any appendages. He/She should be free from any active or latent acute or chronic, medical or surgical infection, infectious disease, infection and skin ailments. Candidate shall be physically and mentally fit to perform duty in any part of the world, day and night.
- Gynaecological Examination (if female candidates only):** The examination covers external genitalia, normal orifices and the perineum, any evidence of stress urinary incontinence, genital prolapse, STD, gonorrhoea.

- Gender (For female candidates):** Any candidate if found to have predominant characteristics of the opposite gender as evident on external physical examination, will be rejected as Unfit. Any candidate having undergone genital reassignment surgery will be declared Unfit.
- Pregnancy (For female candidates):** Any candidate if found pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature will be rejected.

- Consumption of Narcotic, Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NAPS):** Consumption of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances banned under the NDPS Act 1988 shall be a reject criteria for selection into the IAF. AGNIVEERVAYU found either in possession or storing or distributing or consuming such drugs and substances after enrolment shall be liable for disciplinary action including dismissal from the IAF. ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO ALCOHOLISM AND SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS FOLLOWED IN IAF.
- Body Tattoos:** Permanent body tattoos are not permitted, however tattoos only on over face of the five arms (inside of elbow to the wrist) back (dorsal part of the hand/wrist side of the palm and thumb) and buttocks are permitted as per the custom and tradition of the IAF may be considered. Offensive, obscene, indecent, sexist or racist tattoos are prohibited regardless of location on the body. However, right to consume a tattoo, decorative or unnoticeable will rest with the selection centre. Candidates with permanent body tattoos are to submit two Postcard size photographs (close up and distant view) with details of size and type of the Tattoos during the second phase of testing.
- Only Sikh candidates,** whose religion prohibits cutting of hair or shaving of hair, shall be permitted to grow hair and/or retain beard and moustache. Accordingly, those Sikh candidates willing to retain the same as per laid down specification are to get their photographs with beard and moustache.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Agniveerayu will be employed in the Indian Air Force under Air Force Act 1950 for a period of **FOUR years**. Agniveerayu would form a distinct rank in the Indian Air Force, different from any other existing ranks. The Indian Air Force is not obliged to retain Agniveerayu beyond the engagement period of four years.
- On completion of four years of service, based on organization's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Air Force, Agniveerayu will be offered an opportunity to apply for enrolment in the regular cadre of the Indian Air Force as Airman. These applications will be considered in a centralized manner based on objective criteria including performance during their four year engagement period and up to 25% of each specific batch of Agniveerayu will be enrolled in regular cadre of IAF. Agniveerayu will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Air Force. Selection of the Agniveerayu for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Government of India.
- Employability:** Agniveerayu enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organisational interest at the discretion of the Indian Air Force.
- Training:** On being employed, Agniveerayu will be imparted military training based on Indian Air Force requirements.
- Leave:** Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of the Indian Air Force. The following leave is applicable for Agniveerayu during their engagement period:
 - Annual Leave:** 30 days per year
 - Sick Leave:** Based on medical advice by competent Medical Authority.
- Medical and CSD Privileges:** For the duration of their engagement period in the Indian Air Force, Agniveerayu will be entitled for medical facilities at Service hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
- Pay Allowances and Allied Benefits:** Agniveerayu enrolled under this Scheme will be paid an Agniveer package of Rs. 30,000/- per month with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hazard Allowances (as applicable in IAF), Dress and Travel Allowances will be paid. (Items such as leave, clothing, accommodation and Leave Travel Concession (LTC)) shall also be provided as per the existing rules.
- Terminal Benefits - Save Nidhi Package:** AGNIVEERVAYU will be given one time 'Save Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution along with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:

- Note 1:** AGNIVEERVAYU will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund in Indian Air Force.
- Note 2:** There shall be no entitlement to gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits.
- Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation:** AGNIVEERVAYU will be provided non-contributory Life Insurance cover of Rs. 48 Lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIVEERVAYU in the Indian Air Force. AGNIVEERVAYU will not be governed by provisions contained in the Person Regulations/Rules for Indian Air Force.  - 'Agniveer Skill Certificate':** At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill Set certificate will be provided to the AGNIVEERVAYU, highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during their engagement period.
 - Not Enrolled to the ESM Status:** Agniveerayu enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen status after their discharge from the Service on completion of four years engagement period.
 - Agniveerayu will not be permitted to appear in any examination for commissioning in Army/Navy/IAF during the engagement period of four years unless he/she has applied for said exam before getting enrolled.
 - Release at own request prior to completion of engagement period will not be permissible for Agniveerayu. However, in exceptional cases, personnel enrolled as Agniveerayu may be released, with approval of the Competent Authority.

SEQUENCE OF EXAMINATION

MOBILE PHONES/SMART WATCHES/CELLPHONE/WEARABLES ARE PROHIBITED IN TESTING AREAS DURING PHASE I AND PHASE II EXAMINATIONS. CANDIDATES IN POSSESSION OF MOBILE PHONES/SMARTWATCHES/WEARABLES SHOULD DEACTIVATE PERMANENTLY.

- Phase-I**
- Online Test:** Eligible candidates will be sent admit cards by Phase-I of testing on their registered e-mail IDs between 48-72 hrs prior to the examination. Candidates are required to download the admit card (take a colour print) and carry the same to the examination centre. Name of city & exam date will be intimated to the candidates at an earlier date to enable them to plan their movement. This provisional admit card can also be downloaded by the candidates under candidates login on CASB web portal <https://www.airforceindia.com>. All candidates in possession of provisional admit card will undertake Online Test at centres designated / allotted as per their admit card. Online test will be objective type and questions will be bilingual (English & Hindi) except for English paper. Candidates are to bring one blue/black pen and original AADHAAR card along with them for Phase-I testing. Details of the test are as follows:
 - Science Subjects:** Total duration of the online test shall be **60 minutes** and shall comprise of Physics, Mathematics and English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus.
 - Other than Science Subjects:** Total duration of the online test shall be **45 minutes** and shall comprise of English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).
 - Science Subjects & Other than Science Subjects:** Total duration of the online test shall be **85 minutes** and shall comprise of Physics, Mathematics and English as per 10+2 CBSE syllabus and Reasoning & General Awareness (RAGA).
 - Marking pattern for online test:-**
 - One mark for every correct answer.
 - Nil (0) marks for unattempted question.
 - 0.25 marks shall be deducted for each wrong answer.
